Hair

While we love how expressive our hair can be, it should NOT interfere with a dancer's ability to focus in class.

ALL DANCERS should have their hair secured away from the face and neck for all classes.

It is up to the dancer to determine the best way in which to do this for their hair based on length and style of their hair, including but not limited to: Ponytails, Braids, Buns, Wraps and Twists.

Ponytails are NOT considered appropriate for longer hair in Ballet and Pointe classes.

Performance hairstyles will be announced closer to those dates.

Clothing

Leotards and tights are a staple part of a dancer's wardrobe! They allow for freedom of movement and better mobility while letting the instructor view alignment to correct posture and position when necessary.

All female dancers are required to wear a leotard with either tights or leggings to all classes.
